Getting to the start: From, Albion Park Rail.

- Turn on to Illawarra Highway, A48 then drive for 2.6 km
- Turn sharp right onto Tongarra Road, A48, 8 and drive for another 1.9 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Illawarra Highway, A48, 8 and drive for another 490 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Illawarra Highway, A48, 8 and drive for another 7.1 km
- Turn right and drive for another 25 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills \& knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures $\&$ fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies \& call for help at any point
