

## Victoria Reservoir Circuit









Starting from the car park at the start of Mason Bird and Heritage Trail, Carmel, this walk takes you on a circuit around the area, visiting Victoria Dam. The walk offers you a variety of wildlife and flowers. The greatest time to visit the area is the beginning of the spring when there is plenty of water, and the flowers bloom beautifully. You can have a tranquil experience when you reach Victoria Dam, which offers you panoramic views of the azure water with plenty of sunshine. The trial is also suitable for cycling, and picnicking is possible around the dam. Keep in mind that the gates to the reservoir are closed on weekends and after 5.00 pm on weekdays. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (2/6)



**Getting to the start**: From Tonkin Highway, 4, Orange Grove.


- Turn on to Kelvin Road then drive for 970 m
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Kelvin Road and drive for another 1.6 km
- Turn right onto Crystal Brook Road and drive for another 1.1 km
- Turn right and drive for another 4 km
- Turn right onto Canning Road, 41 and drive for another 1.1 km
- Turn right onto Masonmill Road and drive for another 310 m
- Turn left and drive for another 280 m
- Turn sharp right onto Mason Bird Heritage Trail and drive for another 1 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.











After another 35 m veer left.

After another 290 m **continue straight**, to head along Mason Bird Heritage Trail.

After another 1.6 km **continue**straight, to head along Mason Bird
Heritage Trail.


After another 335 m **continue straight**, to head along Mason Bird Heritage Trail.



After another 35 m head through/around the

After another 20 m continue straight.









After another 50 m pass the shelter (about 10 m ahead).



After another 80 m pass the toilet (9 m on your right).



After another 25 m continue straight.


**Start of an optional side trip**: This little side trip will take you along the dam wall for a more panoramic view of the surrounding landscape.

To start this optional side trip veer right here. **Start**.

Find the shelter at the start.



After another 80 m come to the end.




Back at the main route turn right and follow on from the 5 km waypoint.



Then head down the steps (about 55 m long)

Then come to the viewpoint (9 m on your right).





After another 30 m continue straight.
