

Swarbrick Art Walk










Starting from the Swarbrick Art Trail Car Park, North Walpole, this circuit walk takes you to the Swarbrick Art Walk. Immersed in different artworks depicting the historical background of the conservations efforts that have taken place around the area, Swarbrick Art Walk is an informative trail about past events. There is a 39-metre long stainless steel wall. It gives informational and aboriginal messages about the conservation of wildlife over the past 100 years. The area is also host to old karri trees that surround you and bring tranquillity to the area. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From South Western Highway, 1, Walpole.

- Turn on to North Walpole Road then drive for 9.2 km
- Turn left and drive for another 165 m
- $\bullet\,$ Keep left and drive for another 85 m


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- · Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.










Start.

- There is a toilet (about 50 m back from the start).
- Swarbrick Art Trail (about 25 m back from the start).



After another 20 m pass the sign (on your right).



- After another 125 m pass the artwork (on your right)
- After another 15 m pass a seat (on your left).
- Then pass the "Borne The Black Snake" (on your right).
- After another 90 m pass the "Ghost Feather" (on your right).
- After another 35 m pass the "The Colonial Totem" (on your right).
- After another 190 m pass the "Swarbrick Art Trail" (200 m on your left).
- Then pass the "The Golden Torus" (on your right).
- After another 30 m pass the "5000 Seeds" (on your right).



After another 30 m continue straight, to head along Swarbrick Art Trail.



After another 20 m come to the end.
