Starting from Stretton Recreation Reserve car park, Karawatha, this circuit track gives you a tour of the southwestern parts of Karawatha Forest, crossing a creek(bed) twice and optionally visiting Poets Rock along the way. Maculata, Hakea \& Wild May Circuit is a journey that showcases some of Karawatha Forest's most interesting features. Poets Rock is a must-see, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding forest. The forest is home to wallabies, goannas and the occasional bush turkey (Australian brushturkey). With many intersecting tracks, there are plenty of opportunities to extend your journey and explore the forest further. The track is wide and made of gravel. Dogs are welcome on a lead, so bring your furry friend along for the adventure. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Find the Stretton Recreation Reserve at the start.

After another 15 m (from the Wild May Trail) continue straight.
After another 35 m pass the water tap ( 20 m on your left).
After another 6 m pass the shelter ( 20 m on your left).
After another 25 m continue straight.

After another 15 m cross the bridge (about 40 m long)
After another 25 m (at the intersection of Casuarina Track \& Malaleuca Circuit) continue straight, to head along Casuarina Track.
After another 50 m (from the Casuarina Track) continue straight, to head along Casuarina Track.
After another 195 m (from the Casuarina Track) continue straight, to head along Casuarina Track.


After another 245 m (at the
intersection of Maculata Trail \& Casuarina Track) turn right, to head along Maculata Trail.

After another 80 m (from the Maculata Trail) continue straight, to head along Maculata Trail.

Start of an alternate route: An alternate route visiting Poets Rock along the way.


To take the alternate route turn left here. from the Maculata Trail Start (a walking track).

After another 65 m pass a "Poets Rock" (on your right)., has no backrest.


After another 2 m turn left.


Continue another 150 m to find from the Maculata Trail at the end.


At the end of this alternate route, rejoin the main route.

The alternate route finishes here. Veer left to rejoin the main route at the 1.6 km waypoint.


After another 770 m (from the Maculata Trail) continue straight, to head along Maculata Trail.

After another 85 m (from the Maculata Trail) continue straight, to head along Maculata Trail.

The alternate route finishes here left to rejoin the main route at the 1.6 km waypoint.
After another 70 m (from the Maculata Trail) continue straight, to head along Maculata Trail.

After another 200 m (from the Hakea Trail)
continue straight, to head along Hakea Trail.
After another 220 m (from the Hakea Trail)
continue straight, to head along Hakea Trail.
After another 45 m (from the Hakea Trail)
continue straight, to head along Hakea Trail.
After another 20 m (from the Hakea Trail)
continue straight, to head along Hakea Trail.
