

## Red Gum Trail (Darkinjung & Guringai Country)










This walk in Wyrrabalong National Park takes you through a coastal forest. Stop at both lookouts for views over Tuggerah Lake and Toukley. Let us begin by acknowledging the Darkinjung & Guringai people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Pacific Highway, A43


- Turn on to Scenic Drive, A49 then drive for 3.8 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Scenic Drive, A49 and drive for another 1.3 km
- At roundabout, take exit 3 onto Scenic Drive, A49 and drive for another 1.4 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Budgewoi Road, A49 and drive for another 3.4 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Wilfred Barrett Drive, A49 and drive for another 3.1 km


## Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.











After another 4 m continue straight, to head along Red Gum Trail.



Find the gate at the start.




Find the car park at the start.



After 20 m pass the sign (on your left).



After another 10 m (at the intersection of Red Gum Trail & Burrawang Walking Track) veer left, to head along Burrawang Walking Track (a walking track).



After another 195 m (at the intersection of Red Gum Trail & Lilly Pilly Loop Link Trail) veer right, to head along Red Gum Trail.



After another 650 m pass a seat (10 m on your left).



Then come to the viewpoint (10 m on your left).



After another 6 m find the "Tuggerah Lake lookout" (6 m on your left).



This unnamed lookout provides views across Tuggerah Lake, north of The Entrance. The lookout is on the Redgum Trail and consists of a fenced wooden platform with a seat, the beautiful views and atmosphere make this a great spot for a break during a walk in the area.

Start of an optional side trip: Side trip with views over Toukley.



To start this optional side trip veer left here. Start.



After another 10 m come to a seat.



A viewpoint.



The end.



Turn around and retrace your steps back the 10 m to the main route.



Back at the main route continue straight and follow on from the 2.3 km waypoint.



After another 670 m turn right, to head along Red Gum Trail.



After another 90 m find the "Redgum lookout" (5

m on your left)




This unnamed lookout is in the Wyrrabalong National park, north of The Entrance and provides views to the north across part of Tuggerah Lake and Toukley. The lookout is on the Redgum Trail and consists of a fenced wooden platform with a seat. This is a nice, atmospheric spot to take a break on the walk. After another 6 m pass a seat (7 m on your left).



Then come to the viewpoint (15 m on your left).



After another 530 m (at the intersection of Red Gum Trail & Wetland Trail) turn right, to head along Red Gum Trail.





After another 30 m come to the end.
