



Starting at the Blackburn Lake Visitors Centre just off Central Road in Blackburn, this circuit walk loops around Blackburn Lake via the Lakeside Circuit track. Enjoy a scenic stroll surrounded by native bush, with plenty of opportunities to spot local wildlife. This walk takes you an easy-going, well-maintained and signed gravel path within the Blackburn Lake Sanctuary, looping all the way around the serene Blackburn Lake. The lake is home to many ducks, coots, cormorants and herons, and sometimes swans, pelicans, and tortoises can also be seen. There are wooden decks and boardwalks along the way where you can get an even better view of the lake. There are two wonderful playgrounds in the Sanctuary where kids can have a great time playing. The park also offers free parking, picnic tables, barbecues, toilet facilities and an information centre. Bring your four-legged friends, but keep them on a leash. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.


Getting to the start: From CityLink, M1


- Turn on to Toorak Road Off Ramp then drive for 350 m
- Keep left onto Toorak Road Off Ramp and drive for another 10 km
- Turn left onto Blackburn Road, 13 and drive for another 3.1 km
- Turn right onto Wellington Avenue and drive for another 550 m
  - Turn left onto Lake Road and drive for another 15 m
  - At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Central Road and drive for another 325 m
  - Turn right and drive for another 95 m

## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey
- If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.








Find the car park at the start.

Blackburn Lake Visitors Centre (about 25 m back from the start).

After 80 m pass the "Flowers Of The Past" (on your left).



After another 40 m pass a seat (on your left)., has no backrest.

After another 10 m (at the intersection of Lakeside Circuit & Eucalyptus Track) continue straight, to head along Lakeside Circuit.



After another 15 m **veer right**, to head along Lakeside Circuit.



After another 85 m (at the intersection of Hakea Circuit & Lakeside Circuit) continue straight, to head along Lakeside Circuit.

After another 80 m (at the intersection of Lakeside Circuit & Hakea Circuit) continue straight.



After another 80 m **turn left**, to head along Lakeside Circuit.



After another 185 m turn left, to head along Lakeside Circuit.



After another 80 m (at the intersection of Wattie Walk & Lakeside Circuit) continue straight, to head along Lakeside Circuit.



After another 330 m continue straight, to head along Lakeside Circuit.

After another 120 m continue straight, to head along Lakeside Circuit.

After another 25 m cross the bridge (about 7 m lona)

After another 15 m continue straight, to head along Lakeside Circuit.

After another 60 m (at the intersection of Lakeside Circuit & Melaleuca Walk) continue straight, to head along Lakeside Circuit.



After another 2 m (at the intersection of Lakeside Circuit & boardwalk) continue straight, to head along Lakeside Circuit.



After another 105 m come to the viewpoint (20 m on your left).



After another 70 m (at the intersection of Lakeside Circuit & boardwalk) **veer** left, to head along boardwalk.



After another 270 m pass a seat (5 m on your right).



At the intersection of Lakeside Circuit & boardwalk **turn left**, to head along Lakeside Circuit.




