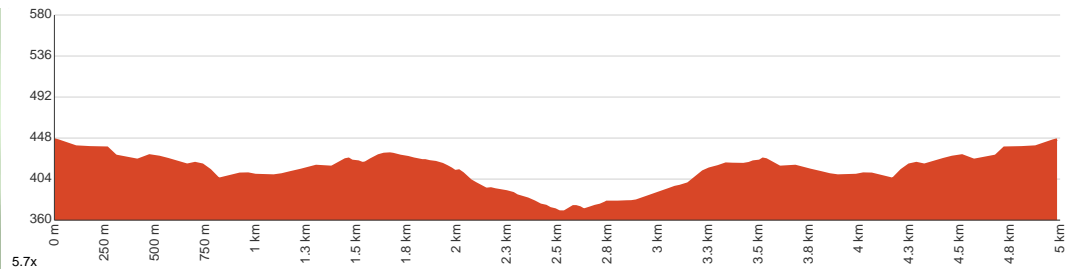
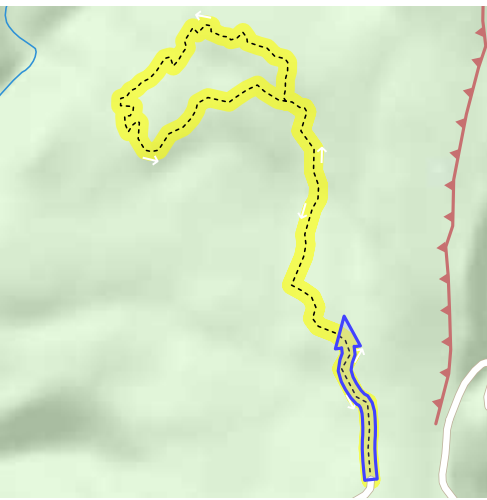

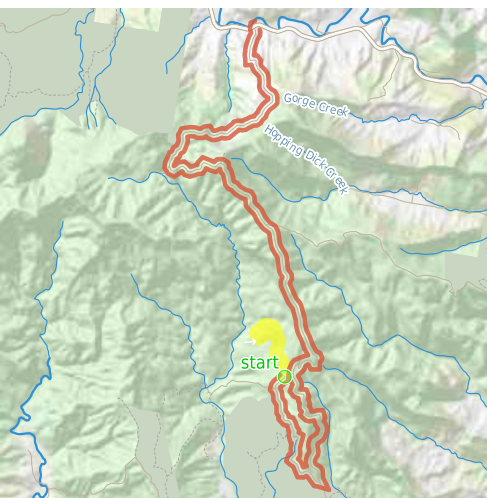
Walk through these section of Toonumbar National Park on a journey among the enormous trees in this lush rainforest. Feel small amongst the giant Bangalow palms, strangler figs and an old-growth stand of red cedar trees . Let us begin by acknowledging the Bundjalung people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
<b>Quality of track</b>	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
<b>Gradient</b>	Short steep hills (3/6)
<b>Signage</b>	Clearly signposted (2/6)
<b>Infrastructure</b>	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
<b>Experience Required</b>	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
<b>Weather</b>	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)

**Getting to the start:** From Summerland Way, B91, Kyogle Council.

- Turn on to Coxs Road then drive for 11.4 km
- Turn slight left onto Toonumbar Forest Drive and drive for another 10.3 km
- Turn sharp right onto Murray Scrub Road and drive for another 3.8 km
- Turn right onto Murray Scrub Carpark Road and drive for another 490 m



**Before you start any journey ensure you;**

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

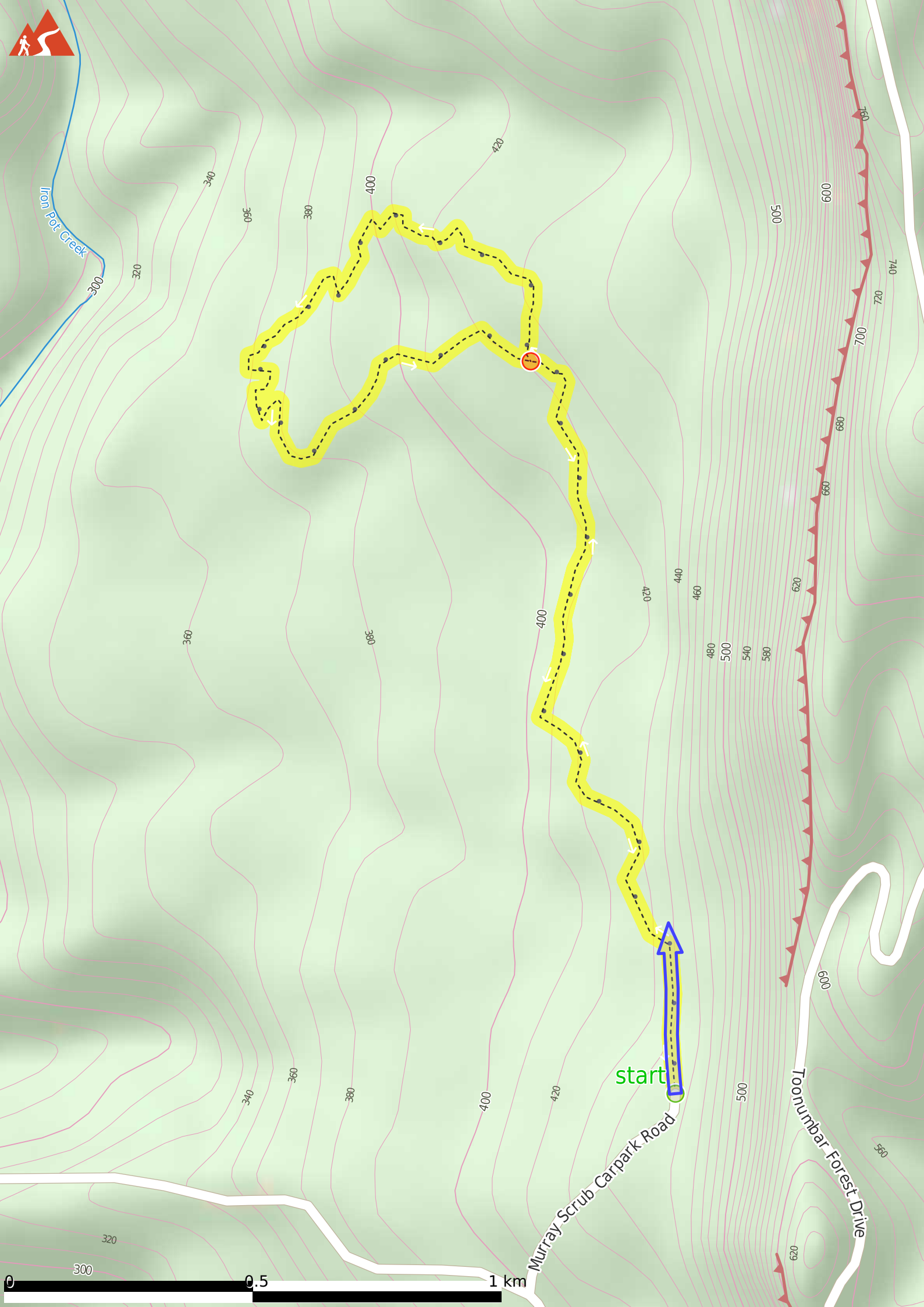
If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

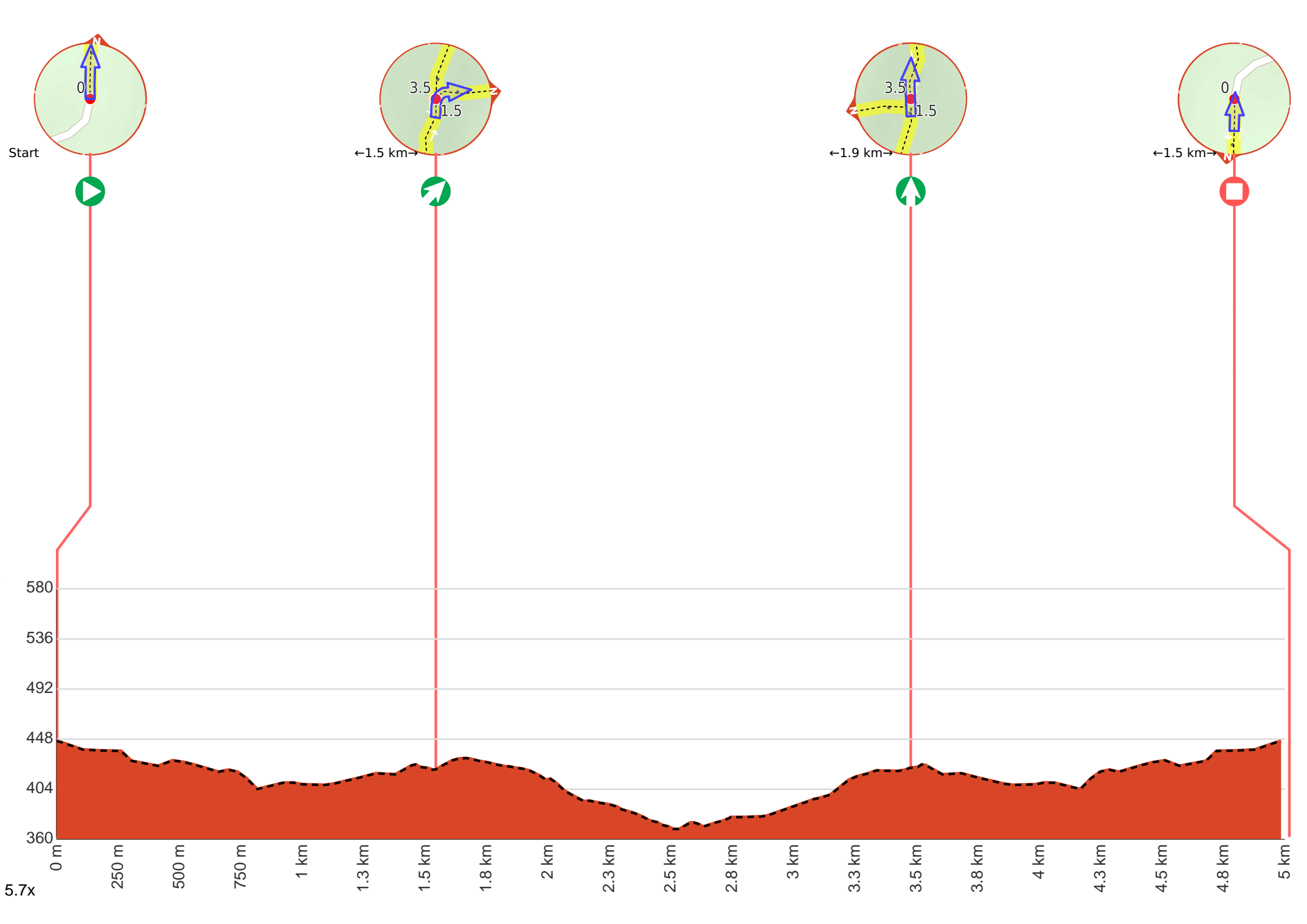
