


Florence Falls Lookout

Starting from the Florence Falls Carpark, Litchfield Park, this walk takes you to the lookout and back via a singular paved track. Florence Falls is a breathtaking sight as it cascades into a plunge pool surrounded by lush monsoon forest. The lookout is stationed above the canopy, therefore, is able to provide you with expansive vistas of the gorge along with wonderful views of the double falls. The falls are permanent, but they are particularly impressive in the wet season. The viewing platform is wheelchair-accessible, ensuring that everyone can enjoy the magnificent scenery. If you wish to camp nearby, both Florence Falls 2WD and 4WD campgrounds are available. However, make sure to book online in advance, as reservations are mandatory. Speaking of booking, a park pass is required for non-residents of the Northern Territory to access this walk, while camping and multi-day walking fees apply to all visitors. Come early to dodge the crowd. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Stuart Highway, Albany Park.


- Turn on to Crater Lake Road then drive for 4.3 km
- Turn left onto Batchelor Road and drive for another 6.2 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 and drive for another 6.6 km
- Turn left onto Litchfield Park Road and drive for another 35.2 km
- Turn right and drive for another 4.6 km


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.







Getting started: From the Florence Falls Carpark, head towards the brown "Florence Falls Lookout - Florence Falls Plunge Pool" sign along the road. Join the paved walking track following the said signage and stay on the track as it veers right in the distance to continue along Florence Falls Lookout Track.



From the Florence Creek Walk **Start** heading along *Florence Creek Walk* (a footpath).



Find the toilet at the start.



Find the emergency call device at the start.



After another 9 m (from the Florence Creek Walk) **continue straight**, to head along Florence Creek Walk.



After another 90 m pass the "Florence Falls" (45 m on your left).



After another 25 m (from the Florence Creek Walk) **veer left**.



Then cross the bridge (about 9 m long)



A viewpoint.



Turn around here and retrace the main route for 145 m to get back to the start.
