## Ms Kellys Walking Track <br> (Biripi \& Worimi Country)

i 45 min to 1 h 15 min


This short loop walk takes you along a historic bullock route through Brimbin Nature Reserve, just north of Taree. Check the signage to learn more about the history of this place and the fascinating story of Isabella Mary Kelly. The walk is very well established with sections of timber boardwalk and bridges over the creeks. Let us begin by acknowledging the Biripi \& Worimi people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Getting to the start: From Wingham Road, 8, Wingham.

- Turn on to Youngs Road then drive for 930 m
- Turn right onto Carey Road and drive for another 3.6 km
- Turn right onto Old Port Macquarie Road and drive for another 3.8 km


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills \& knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures \& fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies \& call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

Getting started: Park at Brimbin picnic area, just off Old Port Macquarie Road, and follow the signs from Tommy Owens Crossing.


At the intersection of Miss Kelly's Walking Track \& Brimbin Picnic Area Road Start heading along Miss Kelly's Walking Track (a walking track).


After another 420 m continue straight, to head along Miss Kelly's Walking Track.


There is a toilet (about 40 m back from the start).

After 55 m pass the sign.

After another 25 m pass the picnic table ( 35 m on your right).


Then pass the BBQ (8 m on your right)


After another 100 m turn left, to head along Miss Kelly's Walking Track.

After another 230 m (at the intersection of Miss Kelly's Walking Track \& Old Port Macquarie Road) veer right, to head along Miss Kelly's Walking Track.
After another 40 m cross the Tommy Owen's Crossing (about 5 m long)


After another 870 m (at the intersection of Old Port Macquarie Road \& Miss Kelly's Walking Track) veer left, to head along Miss Kelly's Walking Track.
