

The Coast Walking Track (Darkinjung & Guringai Country)


1 h 15 min to 1 h 45 min







This short one-way walk in Wyrrabalong National Park takes you from Bateau Bay Beach picnic area to Forresters Beach. Enjoy the great views at lookouts along the way. If you come between May and August this is a great walk for some whale watching. Let us begin by acknowledging the Darkinjung & Guringai people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From The Entrance Road, A49, Bateau Bay.

- Turn on to The Entrance Road, A49 then drive for 220 m
- Turn right onto Bateau Bay Road and drive for another 930 m
- Turn right onto Rushby Street and drive for another 200 m
- Turn right onto Reserve Drive and drive for another 15 m
- Turn left and drive for another 20 m

Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey
- If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.
