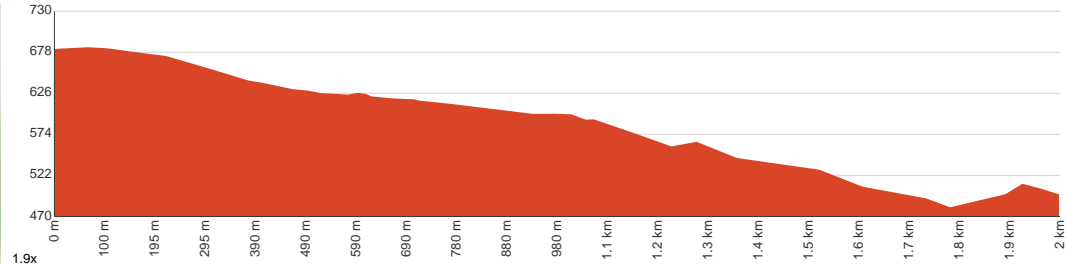
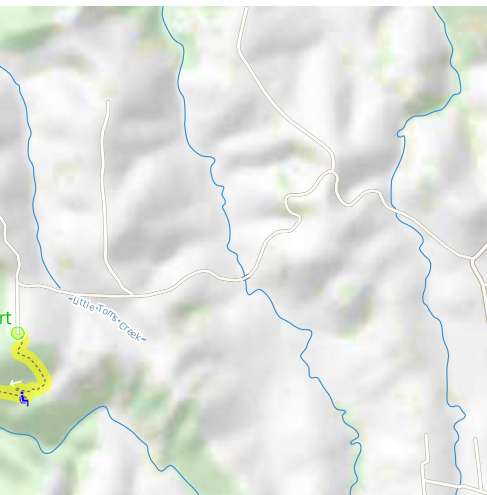
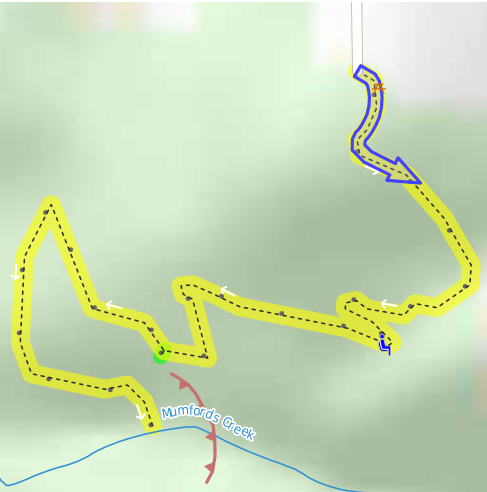

Hard track

Starting from the picnic area, this return walk takes you to the 40m high Rawson Falls for a scenic view from the lookout. Have a picnic and a swim at the swimming hole by the falls. Let us begin by acknowledging the Birpai people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Class 4 of 6 Rough track, where fallen trees and other obstacles are likely	
Quality of track	Rough track, where fallen trees and other obstacles are likely (4/6)
Gradient	Very steep (4/6)
Signage	Directional signs along the way (3/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities (such as cliffs not fenced, significant creeks not bridged) (4/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Foretasted & unexpected storms and severe weather may impact on navigation and safety (4/6)

Getting to the start: From Wingham Road, 8

- Turn on to Innes View Road then drive for 3.7 km
- Turn sharp left and drive for another 310 m

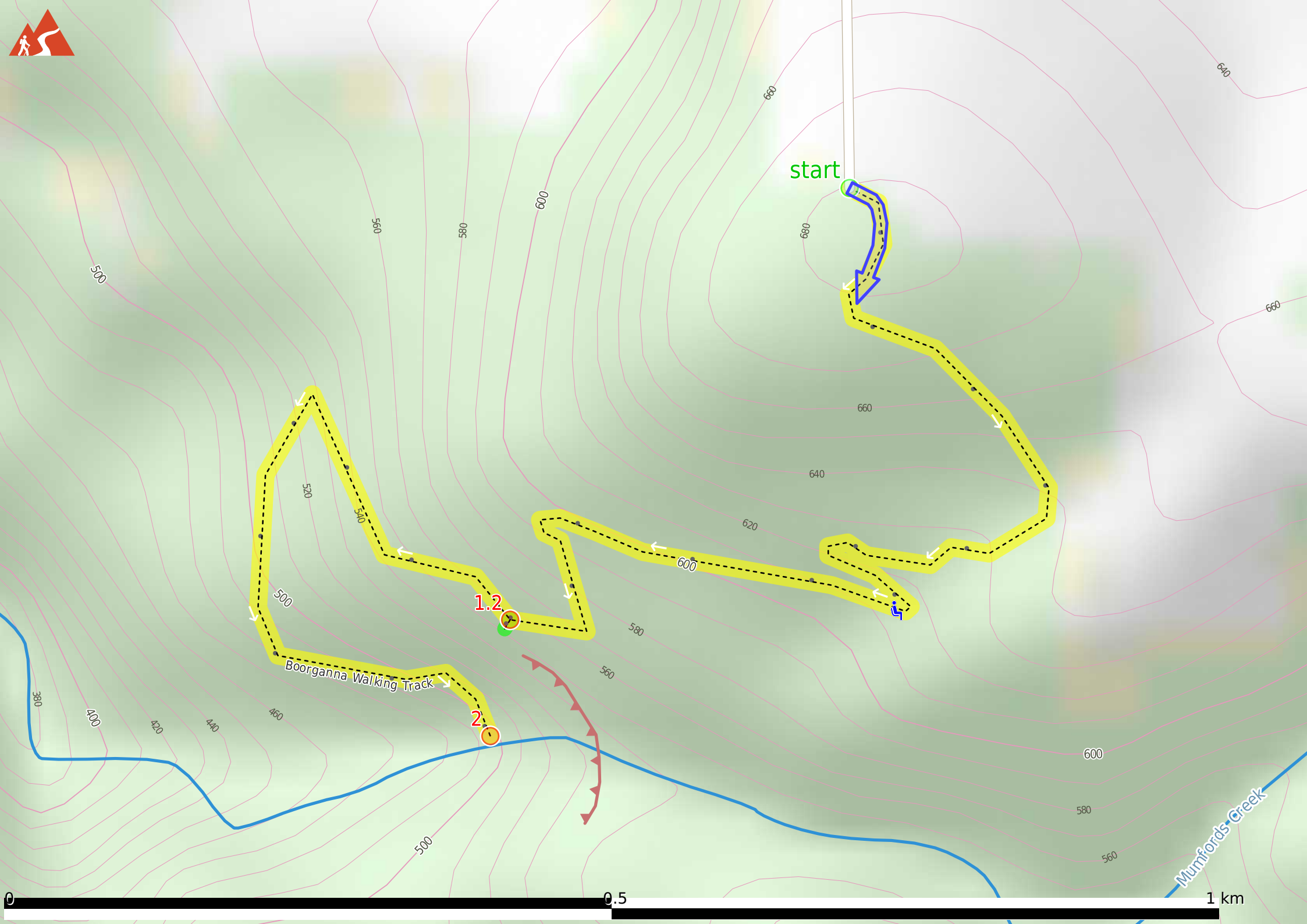
Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

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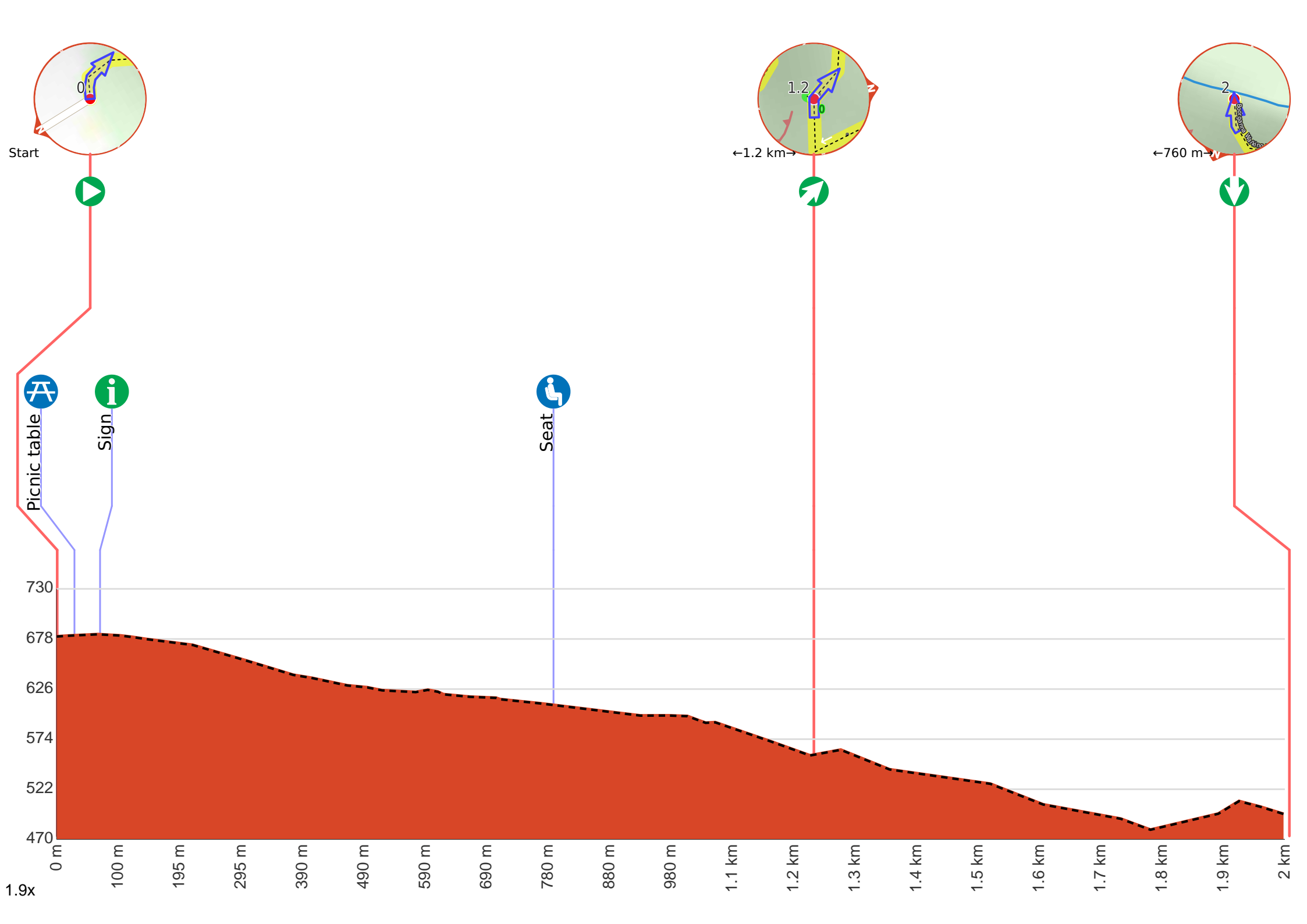

Getting started: From Boorganna Picnic Area car park (off Innes View Road), head towards the sheltered informational signpost along the dirt path. Pass between the said signpost and a “Day Use Only - No Dogs or Firearms” sign along the narrow dirt track. Follow the said track as it meanders deeper into the woodland to continue along Rawson Falls Walk.

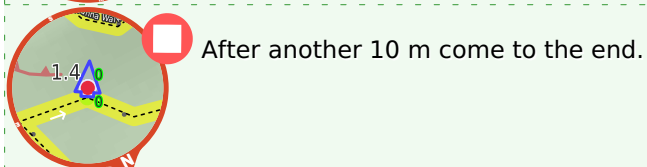
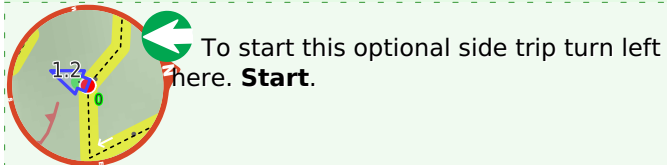



 After 25 m pass the picnic table (10 m on your right).


 After another 40 m pass the sign (on your left).


 After another 720 m pass a seat (on your left)., has a backrest.


Start of an optional side trip: Side trip to a lookout with scenic views of the falls.



 A viewpoint.

 About 130 m past the end is "Rawson Falls".

 Turn around and retrace your steps back the 10 m to the main route.

 Back at the main route continue straight and follow on from the 1.2 km waypoint.
