

## Witches Leap Circuit


(Dharug & Gundungurra Country)












A great circuit walk near Scenic World, Katoomba. This walk heads into a temperate rain forest, following a shrouded trail through Witches Leap, a small creek crossing, before emerging near Katoomba Kiosk. The kiosk is a good spot to stop for a coffee before heading back along the flat trail to Scenic World. Special features of this walk include the great views from Juliet's Balcony. Let us begin by acknowledging the Dharug & Gundungurra people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Great Western Highway, A32


- Turn on to Parke Street, BMD then drive for 105 m
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Bathurst Road, BMD and drive for another 165 m
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Gang Gang Street, BMD and drive for another 105 m
- Turn right onto Lurline Street, BMD and drive for another 1.4 km
- Turn right onto Goyder Avenue and drive for another 140 m
- Turn left onto Katoomba Street and drive for another 10 m
- Keep right onto Katoomba Falls Road and drive for another 325 m
- · Continue onto Katoomba Falls Road, BMD and drive for another 390 m
- Turn left onto Cliff Drive, BMD and drive for another 360 m
- Turn left and drive for another 120 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.









**Getting started:** From the Scenic World main entrance, this walk follows the 'Prince Henry Cliff Walk' signs down the concrete steps and around to the back of the building, where it comes to a wooden footbridge that curves around behind the main car park. At the end of the footbridge, this walk comes to an intersection with the Prince Henry Cliff Walk.

From the intersection, this walk follows the bush track down the gentle hill, winding down some wooden steps as the track bends around to the right. It then arrives at the signposted intersection of the 'Prince Henry Cliff Walk' and the track to the base of the Scenic Railway.



Start



After 45 m find the "Scenic World" (9 m on your left).



Scenic World is one of the most renowned tourist attractions of Katoomba and the Blue Mountains. Located on the cliffs of the Jamison Valley, visitors can enjoy a ride on the Scenic Railway (the world's steepest incline railway) or the Scenic Cableway, into the Jamison Valley, and explore the Scenic Walkway from the base. Alternatively, the Scenic Skyway offers a bird's eye view over the valley, with a glass floor to enhance the experience. Scenic World also features a revolving restaurant, a cafe and a kiosk, in addition to the documentary theatre and souvenir shop. Rides can be purchased, starting from \$16 for adults and \$10 for children, and combination or family passes are available.



Then pass the toilet (20 m on your left).



Then pass a seat (25 m on your left).



After another 100 m pass the toilet (20 m on your right).



Then cross the bridge (about 75 m long)



Then pass the car park (50 m on your left).



After another 75 m **turn right**.



After another 45 m turn right.



After another 25 m find the "Vaniman's Lookout" (on your left).




Vaniman's Lookout is a fenced, long and narrow lookout on the cliff edge, opposite Reids Plateau. The view looks directly over the Three Sisters across the Kedumba Valley, under the Scenic Skyway. The lookout was considered one of the finest views on the Three Sisters in the 1900's. The lookout was named after Chester Melvin Vaniman in 1905, a well-know adventurer and artist from the USA, who visited the Blue Mountains in 1903.



After another 115 m pass a seat (on your right).

**Start of an optional side trip**: An optional side trip to Juliets Balcony.





After another 25 m come to "Juilets Balcony"



Juliets Balcony is a spectacular lookout, perched on top of a rock buttress near Orphan Rock, under the Scenic Skyway. The lookout provides sweeping views of the start of the Kedumba Valley, from Katoomba Falls to the Three Sisters. The lookout is accessed by a staircase, off the Furber Steps track. The fenceline continues along the lookout, forming a long, fenced balcony.



Turn around and retrace your steps back the 25 m to the main route.



Back at the main route turn sharp right and follow on from the 380 m waypoint.







After another 10 m pass the "Plant Life on the Edge" (15 m on your right).



After another 195 m find the "Cliffside lookout" (30 m on your right).



This unnamed, fenced lookout is perched on the cliff's edge on Reids Plateau. The lookout has a bench seat and overlooks the Witches Leap area. The view is mostly of the surrounding trees, with glimpses of cliffs on the other side of the valley. There is a nice view of Witches Leap waterfall.



After another 55 m pass a seat (on your right).



After another 55 m come to the viewpoint (5 m on your left).



After another 25 m pass a seat (10 m on your right)., has a backrest.



Turn left.



**Start of an optional side trip**: An optional side trip to Katoomba Falls Kiosk.



To start this optional side trip veer right here. **Start**.

Find the Katoomba Falls Reserve at the start.



After another 35 m come to the end.



About 15 m past the end is a car park.



Turn around and retrace your steps back the 55 m to the main route.



Back at the main route turn right and follow on from the 790 m waypoint.



After another 20 m continue straight.



After another 40 m pass the "Blue Mountains National Park" (on your right).



Then pass the pay phone (55 m on your right).



After another 80 m continue straight.



After another 45 m cross the bridge (about 7 m long)



After another 15 m pass the "Witches Leap" (20 m on your left).



After another 55 m continue straight.



After another 50 m cross the bridge (about 75 m long)
