Getting to the start: From Cargo Road

- Turn on to Old Canobolas Road then drive for 5 km
- Turn right onto Mount Canobolas Road and drive for another 750 m
- Turn right onto Towac Way and drive for another 1.7 km
- Turn sharp left and drive for another 55 m

- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills \& knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures \& fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies \& call for help at any point
