## Heritage Walking Track

(Awabakal \& Worimi Country)
خ 30 min to 1 h

Follow this short circuit walk from the remains of an 1870's stone bridge abutments to the brick tower that was a ventilation shaft from the old mine. Let us begin by acknowledging the Awabakal \& Worimi people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Newcastle Link Road, A15

- Turn on to Newcastle Link Road, A15 then drive for 1.9 km
- Turn right onto Woodford Street and drive for another 2 km
- Turn sharp right onto Minmi Road and drive for another 670 m
- Turn sharp right onto Blue Gum Hills Road and drive for another 480 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Blue Gum Road and drive for another 35 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills \& knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures $\&$ fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies \& call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.
