

Pinnacle Walk and Lookout (Bundjalung Country)



30 min to 45 min








This short return walk in Border Ranges National Park starts from Tweed Range Scenic Drive and takes you through World Heritage-listed rainforest to the Pinnacle lookout with scenic views over the park. Let us begin by acknowledging the Bundjalung people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.







Class 2 of 6 Clear and well formed track or trail	
Quality of track	Clear and well formed track or trail (2/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (2/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (2/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (2/6)

Getting to the start: From Summerland Way, B91

- Turn on to Gradys Creek Road then drive for 11.2 km
- Turn right onto Simes Road and drive for another 3.2 km
- Turn sharp left onto Forest Road and drive for another 10.8 km
- Keep right onto Tweed Range Scenic Drive and drive for another 4.2 km
- Turn right onto Tweed Range Scenic Drive and drive for another 4.3 km


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- · Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.









Find the car park at the start.

After 35 m pass the sign (9 m on your left).

After another 220 m come to "Pinnacle Lookout".

Turn around here and retrace the main route for 255 m to get back to the start.
